Acadia National Park September 8 – 13, 2015

I'm happy to announce a workshop in Acadia National Park to be held September 8 – 13 2015.

Acadia, along the rocky coast of Maine, is one of the most varied and dramatic of our National Parks. The possibilities for photography are infinite, including dramatic pink granite rock ledges, cobblestone beaches, tranquil ponds, lichen covered hiking paths and the beauty of a sunrise from Cadillac Mountain. Numerous quaint villages and small harbors surround the park area adding to the scenic possibilities.

We may shoot at all times of day depending on the light and the nature of the locations. We'll be on the coast, the Cadillac summit, the ponds, the trails, carriage roads, and the villages. Much of our shooting will be at sunrise (6:AM, so up early to be on location) and late PM (sunset at 7:PM). We may be walking a mile or more over rocks or rough terrain, so a moderate level of fitness and comfort with this type of activity is expected.

The workshop is designed for a group of 8-10 people. It is assumed that everyone will have a working knowledge of their camera and the ability to use Lightroom to organize and share their pictures. Our focus will be on the photography, however we will have some mid-day time to review our images. Laptops are encouraged for this part of the workshop.

The workshop fee is \$1195 and includes all photography activities. Additional charges, not included in the workshop fee, would be for transportation, lodging, meals, park entry fees, and other items of a personal nature.

Rooms have been reserved at the Atlantic Eyrie Hotel in Bar Harbor. Allow me to provide them with your name and a 10% discount will be provided when you make your reservation. The room comes with breakfast (hot and cold) and free wifi. Room sharing can be arranged. There is a direct flight from National Airport to Bangor, which is about an hour from Bar Harbor. Please wait for the go ahead before making flight reservations. Vehicle sharing will be coordinated.

We would depart in the morning on Tuesday, Sept 8 and return mid afternoon on Sunday, Sept 13.
