Depart the U.S. on Saturday, July 24, and return to the U.S. on Sunday Aug 1, 2027

- Sat, 7/24 Morning flights to Nuuk. Dinnertime arrival.
- Sun, 7/25 Guided walking tour of Nuuk with time to explore the city and the National Museum
- Mon, 7/26 Flight to Ilulissat. Midnight sun cruise
- Tue, 7/27 Daytime cruise in the Icefjord, evening walk to Sermermiut
- Wed, 7/28 Explore Ilulissat, Icefjord Center, and Sermermiut; Midnight Sun cruise
- Thurs, 7/29 Explore Ilulissat, Icefjord Center, and Sermermiut; Midnight Sun cruise
- Fri, 7/30 All day cruise to Oqaatsut (small traditional Greenlandic village) and to find whales
- Sat, 7/31 Flight to Nuuk
- Sun, 8/1 Return flights to the US

I'll arrange our specific itinerary based on weather and light. Above is a pretty good idea of how our days will work, but we may vary our plans based on what the light offers. Some of our most beautiful light may be very late evening, so we'll adapt to the light as much as we can, going out at 10-10:30PM and returning at 12:30-1:00AM. We'll shoot during the daytime as well – the community is very colorful, and Sermermiut is a UNESCO heritage area with a fantastic endpoint as the ice flows from the fjord into Disko Bay.

Our daytime/evening cruises should be 2.5 hours duration. We'll see and photograph a lot in that time. And I have arranged one all day cruise to a small community. We'll combine this with locating whales in the ice (hopefully). I have arranged for our charter boats to pick us up at the hotel dock for our cruises, so no walking or shuttling to a commercial dock – it should all be very convenient. During the evening it will be chilly on the water, but our boats have nice heated inside cabins so we can pop in and out as we want. (But I think you'll want to be mostly out...).

The tour is designed for 8-10 people. The cost of the workshop is \$6,750 for single accommodations and assumes 8-10 participants. The cost includes: all hotels and breakfasts, all boat excursions, airport transfers to/from our hotels, and admissions to the National Museum of Greenland in Nuuk, the UNESCO Heritage area in Ilulissat, and the Icefjord Center in Ilulissat. All of our accommodations have ensuite baths. In Ilulissat we will be right on the water likely with icebergs floating outside.

In the event we travel with fewer people there would be an additional charge but let's see how many are coming and then that can be determined, if necessary.

Additional costs include our international flights, our flight from Nuuk to Ilulissat, travel insurance, meals other than breakfast, and anything of a personal nature, as well as any individual transportation other than that with the group.

There is a direct flight from Newark to Nuuk on United which is what I would recommend that we all take. There are limited days that the flights come and go and our schedule is arranged with those days (and hotel availability) in mind. There will be flights on Air Greenland between Nuuk and Ilulissat. For this we would all need to be on the same flight which I will coordinate. I'll have specific flight info as the schedules are published. Everyone will purchase their own airline tickets.

Cancellations/refunds:

I will have to make some non-refundable payments for our tour. With notification by March 31, 2027, I can offer refunds of the balance payment. The deposit is not refundable unless the trip is full and someone can replace you. In that case there would be a \$350 cancellation fee.

After April 1, 2027, if the trip is full and another person is able to replace you, I can offer refunds of the deposit and balance payment. In that case there would be a \$650 cancellation fee.

I would strongly suggest trip insurance to cover anything unforeseen.
